

eVisa

The new digital proof of immigration, and how it affects you as an international worker



As the world relies more and more on digital communications, UKVI have implemented a digital replacement for proof of immigration status. Biometric residence permits (BRP) and biometric residence cards (BRC) are now being replaced with digital proof of immigration, called an eVisa.

Key information

- All existing visa holders who currently prove their rights with a BRP, BRC or a passport containing a visa vignette or ink stamp, need to create a UKVI account to access their eVisa.
- **This needs to be completed by 31st December 2024** to ensure you can prove your rights without delay or difficulty.
